On August 02, 2017 at the 2017 FBINAA National Conference held in Washington, D.C., Chief Deputy Grady Sanford of the Forsyth County Sheriff's Office was elected to the Executive Board of the Federal Bureau of Investigation National Academy Associates (FBINAA) as the Section III Representative.
