FEMALE DIES AFTER BEING HIT BY A VAN

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE:

On April 27, 2017 at 6:17 a.m., a 71 year-old female died after being hit by a Dodge Caravan while attempting to cross Windermere Parkway at New Gate Drive.

According to Deputy First Class Andrew Ives, Traffic Specialist with the Forsyth County Sheriff's Office, Maria Vinci of Cumming, Ga., was pronounced deceased at Northside Hospital Forsyth after being transported there by ambulance.

A 2002 Dodge Caravan, operated by Adrian Rowland, a 41 year-old from Sugar Hill, Ga., was traveling south on Windermere Parkway approaching New Gate Drive. Mr. Rowland observed Maria Vinci in his lane as he reached the intersection and attempted to steer to the left while braking but the Dodge Caravan struck Maria Vinci in the roadway.

The cause of the crash is still under investigation by the Forsyth County Sheriff's Office Traffic Specialist Unit.
