CHILD DIES FROM HER INJURIES

IMMEDIATE RELEASE

August 10, 2017

The Forsyth County Sheriff's Office has been notified that the child wounded in the incident on Monday the 7th has died from her injury. The child was an 11 month old female.

As previously reported, on Monday the 7th deputies responded to domestic dispute on Carleen Court in South Forsyth. The female victim called from a neighbor's house and said her husband threatened her and their young daughter with a handgun.

For the next three hours our deputies and a family member attempted to communicate with the husband through various means.

The SWAT team entered the house with a negotiation phone and heard the sounds of the infant upstairs. The team immediately went to the infant and found the husband/father dead from an apparent self-inflicted gunshot wound, and the child wounded from a gunshot. The child was treated on the scene by a SWAT medic and rushed to a local hospital in critical condition. From there she was airlifted to an Atlanta area hospital.

Salman Ashraf, a 34 year-old male, was pronounced dead on August 7, 2017.

The mother is staying with family.
