Keeping with our commitment to impact the drug trade in Forsyth County, I am pleased to announce one of several recent narcotics arrests that are making a difference in our community. We are actively targeting those selling drugs to our youth and most vulnerable. If you are thinking of selling drugs in Forsyth County, get ready to join the likes of those below. I have no tolerance for drug dealers in our community.

On February 7, 2017 the newly expanded Sheriff's Office Narcotics Unit conducted a Search Warrant on Bagley Drive in South Forsyth County. Our narcotics unit confiscated thousands of dollars' worth of Methamphetamine and Marijuana. Along with the drugs our detectives recovered multiple illegal firearms. The firearms did not have serial numbers and one firearm recovered had been reported stolen out of the City of Milton Police Department on December 24th, 2016.

Arrested are;

- William Marsh Pruett, a 39 year-old male charged with; Trafficking Methamphetamine, Sale of Methamphetamine, Possession of Methamphetamine with Intent to Distribute, Possession of Firearms during the Violation of Georgia Control Substance Act, Possession of Schedule III drugs, Possession of Drug Related Objects and Theft by Receiving a Stolen Firearm.
- Jason Kyle Bagwell, a 43 year-old male charged with: Possession of Methamphetamine and Possession of Drug Related Objects.

Both are currently enjoying our new Forsyth County Detention Center under no bond.
