Deputies Respond to Barricaded Subject

On July 9, 2020 at approximately 6:55 p.m., Forsyth County Sheriff's deputies responded to 6515 Mountain Vista Court in reference to a domestic incident with injuries. The caller advised the female and juvenile that reside in the house had exited and are at a neighbor's home. Deputies also learned that the male, identified as 45-year-old Stephan Reynolds, had several weapons in the home.

Forsyth County SWAT team was activated when Mr. Reynolds would not come out of the home. After several hours, the SWAT team was able to locate Mr. Reynolds inside of the home. He was in close proximity to an AR-15 rifle at the time of his arrest. Stephan Reynolds has been charged with 2 counts of False Imprisonment, Aggravated Assault with a Gun, Aggravated Battery and Cruelty to Children. He was taken to the Forsyth County Jail where he is being held on no bond.
